

By registering for a Taster Class and then Enrolling your son/daughter at JLP Performing Arts (JLP) you are accepting the below Terms & Conditions.

Payments

1. Classes must be booked and paid for in full (or monthly instalments setup) in advance of the students' first lesson
2. JLP classes are run and charged on a fixed termly basis and payment, or monthly payment schedule, is due for all lessons in advance of the term. In the cases of absences, JLP will not give refunds
3. Class invoices will be emailed to you before the end of the preceding term, however, any additional invoices i.e. show, examinations, private lessons will be invoiced to you when applicable
4. All invoices must be paid by the deadline date given. In the case of late payments, an additional £10 will be added to your invoice
5. All fees can be paid by card, BACS or monthly instalments as detailed on your invoice
6. Receipts of payment will not be given unless specifically requested

Class

7. Students are expected to behave in an appropriate manner in class, and disruptive or disrespectful behaviour will not be tolerated
8. Students should not leave the dance studio until collected by their parent/guardian.
9. It is important to stay hydrated during class, so students can bring a bottle of water into class, but no other food or drink are allowed, and students should go to the toilet before class
10. Parents are responsible for all minors on the Studio premises that are not students in a studio taking a class. Children under the age of 8 years should never be unaccompanied on the Studio Premises.
11. It is imperative that all parents, guardians and students respect the premises and studios in which classes are held. Anybody found to be acting inappropriately in the building will be held responsible and further action may be taken
12. JLP does not accept aggressive or violent behaviour towards any member of staff, in doing so further action may be taken and JLP will terminate any agreement with immediate effect
13. JLP follows safe dance practice to reduce the risk of injury and accepts no liability for any injuries sustained whilst participating in the physical activity of a dance class or on the Studio Premises.
14. Students are required to wear the correct uniform as detailed on our website, with their hair in a neat bun for Ballet, and a neat ponytail for Modern/Tap
15. JLP accepts no responsibility for loss or damage of personal belongings or property whilst on the Studio Premises.
16. Occasionally the teacher will need to use physical contact with the student when correcting and assisting dance movements. All JLP staff hold current DBS certificates
17. In the rare case that classes may be cancelled, JLP will offer an alternative date to make up classes if possible
18. The opportunity for students to take examinations will be at the sole discretion of the teacher
19. When preparing for examinations, it is likely that students will need to attend additional lessons

Administration

20. If any parent or student is in breach of these Terms & Conditions, JLP reserves the right to terminate their membership at the school with no refund issued
21. If you decide to withdraw from JLP, half a term's notice is required in writing (email or letter). If notice is given after the half term break then full fees for the next term will still need to be paid
22. In agreeing with JLP's terms and conditions, you are agreeing that you are happy for us to use your data for JLP business purposes only. Your information will not be shared with any other third party, except for examination bodies (ISTD)
23. It is your responsibility to ensure that you read all correspondence from JLP and respond where necessary and requested
24. JLP reserves the right to photograph and/or film students in lessons, films or school events for marketing, website and social media. JLP also reserves the right to allow third party photography or film companies (acting on behalf of JLP) the use of camera or recording equipment during any show or JLP event
25. Updates to JLP's terms and conditions may be made from time to time, these will be sent out to you via email and it would be your responsibility to then let the administration team know if you do not agree. No response would mean that you are happy to continue as a member of JLP
